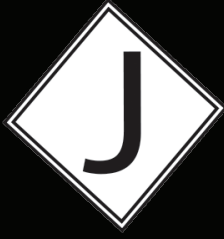

Emergency Response Actions



Fire

- When you hear the alarm, evacuate immediately
- Call 911
- Take your belongings
- Help others
- Do not return until okayed by authorities



Tornado/Severe Weather

- Monitor weather information
- Take shelter on lowest level of building, in a restroom or other interior space away from windows and glass
- If outdoors, lie in a ditch or low area, or crouch near a strong building



Medical

- Call 911
- Stay on the phone for instructions
- Remain with victim(s) until first responders arrive



Armed Intruder

- Go to a safe place
- Call 911
- Leave if safe to do so
- If not safe to leave, lock or barricade yourself in a room
- Stay put until authorities say it is safe



Hazardous Materials

- Call 911
- Evacuate the affected area
- Make sure the area stays clear until authorities tell you it is safe

Make sure you get timely emergency notifications.
